




Dates to Remember

2-11 Alarm 2434 N Mason Ave July 01, 2020

Battalion 8 responding to a Still Alarm at 2434 N. Mason. Upon arrival reports of a fire in 2 alley garages and a 1.5 story coach house. Battalion 8 called for a Still and Box. Fire now was in three 1.5 story dwellings and 2 alley garages. An EMS Plan 1 was requested for 9 fire victims. Soon Battalion 8 requested a 2-11

alarm. Canteen 401 responded to the fire. Fire was in three 1.5 story dwellings and the 2 alley garages. 2-2-2 took command of the fire. Rehab 572 and a CTA cooling bus ordered to the fire. 2 Engines and a Truck to the scene for rehab. Temperatures were in the 90s. 2-1-5 struck out the fire an hour later.





2-11 Alarm 8723 S Bishop Ave. July 05, 2020

Battalion 21 and units responding to a fire at 8723 S Bishop. Upon arrival, fire was showing in a 1.5 story bungalow. 2 lines working. Later Battalion 21 requesting a MAYDAY elevating the alarm to a Still and Box with an EMS Plan 1 for a firefighter lost in the building. Rescue was made and the firefighter was taken in fair condition at the hospital. 2-2-5 took command of the fire. Due on the Mayday 2-1-


30 on scene and took command of the fire now. Moments later he requested a 2-11 alarm. Canteen 403 responding to the 2-11. The fire was struck out about an hour later by 2-1-5.






Water Rescue 5100 Simmons Drive July 24, 2020

Battalion 9 responded to a man threatening to jump from the rocks at Foster Ave Beach. A water response was also on the way. SWAT team with negotiators were called to the scene. Subject was not talking and climbed a light tower above the break wall. Canteen 401 was called to the scene after a 3-hour standoff. After a couple more hours the subject climbed down and was taken into custody by M-3.






Looting again in downtown Chicago August 10, 2020

What started as a quiet weekend didn't stay that way to long. A call to CPD of a man with a gun in the 5700 block of S. Aberdeen St. Police units arriving saw a man running from the scene with a gun and started shooting at the police. Several 10-1s were requested. The police fired back and struck the offender. All this happening in the middle of a block party in the Englewood neighborhood. Lots of false stories developed. It took a while to bring the crowd under control.



Little did CPD know that over social media the Englewood neighborhood was planning an attack of downtown. That night the clock struck midnight and the Loop was filled with looters. Smashing and breaking into a hundred stores on Michigan Ave and State St. It took 400 officers and over six hours to disperse the crowds. By orders of the mayor all bridges were raised downtown, expressway ramps were closed and the CTA was shut down in the loop. Over 100 people were arrested.







2-11 Alarm Fire 3324 N Albany Ave. August 20, 2020


Engine 106 and the group responding to a Still Alarm 3324 N. Albany Ave. Upon arrival Engine 106 reported fire in a 2.5 story apartment building. Fire in the rear. Truck 13 arrived on scene and reported fire extended to a second similar type building. He then requested a Still and Box. Fire was heavily involved in the rear of both buildings. Buildings were 35x75. 2.5 story and a 3 story frame. 2-2-2reported on scene and requested the rehab rig. Soon after a 2-11 alarm was requested for rehab. Canteen 401 responded. The fire was struck out shortly after that.
